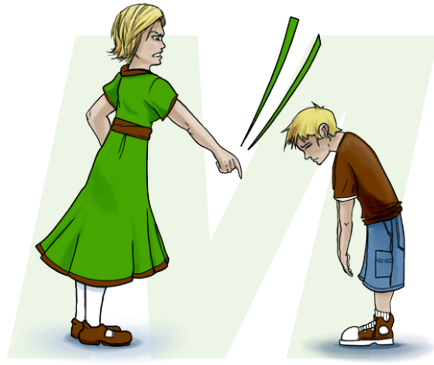




High and Clipped

'Cim Siab' is said at the highest range of your natural voice and clipped at the end.



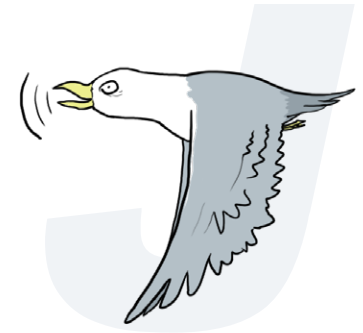
"GET HERE RIGHT NOW!"

'Cim Niam' is said at the lowest range of your natural voice and clipped at the end, like an angry mother saying, "You get here right now!"



Low to high.

'Cim Kuv' is said starting just above monotone and swooping upwards, just like the tone of voice you would use to ask a question in English.



"Koj"

'Cim Ntu' is said starting from a high tone and quickly dropping below monotone, 'Koj' would be said like a seagull says 'CAW!!'



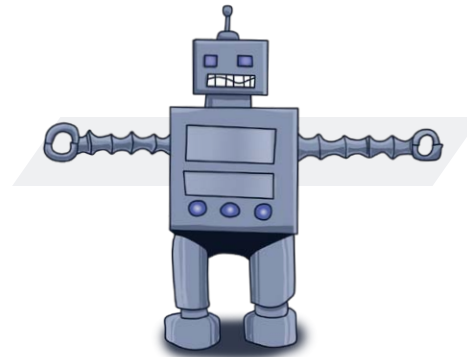
"I'm sooo bored."

'Cim Mus' is said below monotone and drawn out longer than a normal tone, just like someone would say "I'm sooooo bored."



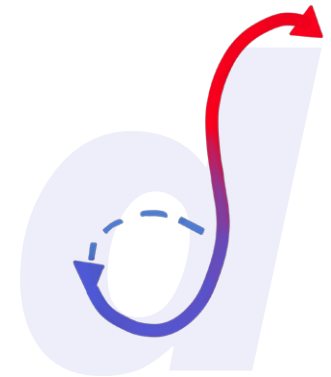
"Boo!"

'Cim Neeg' tone is said quickly, breathy, and below monotone, just like one would say, "Boo!" to surprise someone.



"Emotions dont compute"

When the word ends in a vowel, it is 'Cim Ua'. 'Cim Ua' is said with no emotion. When there is no emotion, you say it like a robot.



Like 'Cim Kuv', but Longer.

'Cim Tod' is said just like 'Cim Kuv', from low swooping up, but more drawn out.
